Paragraph 213 Task Force Update

The Task Force on the future of the 4 Tuolumne County Methodist Churches has prepared recommendations. The District Superintendent, David Niu, the Task force leaders and the members of the Central Valley District Committee of Church Location and Building are asking us to pick a date and time when most of us can attend a meeting and discuss the recommendations. The Saturday dates we can pick from are May 28 or June 4 or June 18. Our meeting will be held at our church, but there will also be a Zoom connection. There are many issues to discuss. We will pick our favorite date and time at the May1st Church Council meeting.

The Minutes of the April 9 Task Force meeting discuss some of the issues. Copies of those minutes and a copy of the 23 page final assessment of Sonora UMC are in the Fireside room.

Merging means that 2 of the churches will join together and one of their buildings will have to be sold as they cannot afford to maintain both churches

Yoking means that the churches will remain separate, maintaining their own buildings, but they will together support one pastor. The Pastor will work half time and each church will pay the pastor 1/4th of his salary.

The recommendations are:

Tuolumne and Soulsbyville will merge. After the merger, they will together decide which church building they will sell.

Jamestown will merge with Sonora, or the Tuolumne/Soulsbyville combination, or be closed and the Conference will take over their building.

Sonora will be yoked with the merged Soulsbyville-Tuolumne UMC and that all the churches will engage in discussions every 6 months with each other and the District Superintendent to explore the advisability to have one United Methodist Church serving the county. Sonora currently only has enough money to support a 1/4 time pastor. Hopefully we will figure out how to grow during the year we are yoked.

These are recommendations and we will have the chance to vote on them.
